



**It's as simple as: A - Left In - Left Out, B - Right In - Right Out
or C - Straight Ahead - Either Lane
(unless arrows on the road indicate otherwise)**

- Plan ahead so you are in the correct lane before you reach the roundabout. Directional arrows on the road help you choose the correct lane.
- Give way to all vehicles already on the roundabout.
- Travel only in the direction indicated by arrows on the road or advance direction signs.
- Always travel in a clockwise direction on the roundabout.
- Use the left lane to turn left.
- Use the right lane for a right turn or U-turn.
- If going straight ahead use either lane.
- If you are travelling through the roundabout in the left lane, you must give way to all vehicles exiting from the right lane.
- Exit the roundabout by the same lane in which you entered.
- Use your left indicator before exiting to show other drivers what you are doing.
- Keep a special look out within the roundabout for large trucks, motorcyclists and cyclists because of their size and/or vulnerability.
